Greens Committee Highlights

As most of you know The Webster Board initiated the “Greens Committee” a few years ago with the objective to work closely with the Webster Golf Course Management and the Ground’s Superintendant to come up with recommendations that would better the Webster Golf Course. These recommendations come from members, guests, and management. Over the past few years we hope that you have seen steady improvements. We would like to list some of the improvements for your viewing pleasure and hope that you will continue to support us in making Webster Golf Course better and successful!

2013 Improvements being worked on:

- Drainage improvements
 - Hole #8 drainage for fairway in front of Ladies tee box
 - Hole #18 front right bunker is getting new drainage
- Right bunker for hole #12 will be reduced in size – will fill in front of bunker to move it away from green
- Leveling of White Tee Box hole #12 (* Note1)
- Fairway bunker on hole #4 will be removed – will help clean up the cart path area for hole 4
- Aerate hole 4 and 12 from 150 yard markers to end of fairway and over seeding them to promote better fairway conditions (* Note1)

Previous year’s improvements:

- Memorial site added alongside of hole 5 (* Note1)
- Building, and continuous improvement of the 16th event tee area
- Multiple trees removed or trimmed
- New tee box add for women on hole 10
- Multiple bunkers removed (holes 9, 11, 12, 16)
- Open clean up days that take place at the start of each season (* Note1)
- Tee box maintenance program implemented in 2010 (* Note1)
- Drainage improvement to holes 6, 13, and 10
- Spike cleaners add to ball washers on several holes
- New walking bridges on hole 4, 10, and 17

We hope that each of you will continue to help us make Webster Golf Course a great experience for all.
